Eilat- Bonus Days

All weekly programs can be prolonged with three more days to visit Israel's southest city Eilat, except on weekends.

Day 1

Drive from Jerusalem along the dead sea to Timna park. Feel like you are traveling back in time when you venture into this geological wonderland! Learn about the ancient copper mines, King Solomon's Pillars and the enormous multi-colored rock formations. A man-made lake in the middle of the desert offers shaded areas to enjoy the panoramic view. Then, visit the Red sea underwater observatory. Enter the amazing world of the Red Sea, one of the most scenic seas in the world. The Park maintains an extensive exhibition of fish and other living creatures native to the Red Sea, including aquariums, a Shark Tank, Turtle & Stingray Pool and underwater observatories. Overnight stay in Eilat.

Day 2

A day of leisure. Spend a full day experiencing an activity of your choice- water sports, parasailing, scuba diving, or just resting and tanning at the pool or at the beach.

Day 3

Mitzpe Ramon crater. Enjoy spectacular views of the desert and witness this unique geological phenomenon. Israel's largest national park, the crater is located at the peak of Mount Negev. At first sight the crater appears as if it was formed by a meteor impact but in truth is a natural formation. Next we'll stop for camel rides & refreshments at a Bedouin settlement. Then, we will learn about the thrilling history of Israel's legendary Air Force at the IDF Air force museum, where you will be able to see an actual fighter aircraft and aerospace displays.

Overnight stay in Tel Aviv.
